Secondary Audio-Video Systems include areas with a TV and local Audio and/or Video equipment. These areas generally are not part of the House Distributed Audio-Video or Media Systems.

- **Entertainment**
- **Private use**
- **Lifestyle Flexibility**
- **Simple Operation**

Secondary Audio-Video equipment, such as a Blu-ray DVD player, Video Game Consoles, or iPod, is typically located in or on top of furniture (for the purpose of convenience & personal use).

These areas are maybe integrated with other systems such as, Lighting and HVAC, and are configured using the Control system.

The simple to use Touch Panel or Remote Control eliminates the need for multiple hand held remotes to operate the equipment.
